n January 15, 1978, the birth date of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., I was ordained into Christian ministry. My ordination date was quite intentional. or more than 150 years, the First Congregational Church has been reaching beyond its doors to meet the spiritual, emotional, and physical needs of its Atlanta neighbors.

Whether literally providing cool water to thirsty passersby needing respite from the heat and segregation of Jim Crow Atlanta – or today offering cool jazz to the parched spirits of audiences in need of musical relief from a stressful world – First Congregational Church has always embraced its mission on

beyond Sunday morning, touching the lives of people of all ages through its outreach programs. Providing after-school tutoring to children in need and child care support for working parents, offering cultural enrichment through music instruction, addressing the food insecurity of neighbors, reducing isolation and creating community for the elderly – these are just some of the ways First Church has been meeting community needs across the decades.



As we look to the future, we see the strains on community all around us – rising political polarization, a growing economic divide leaving many behind in poverty, greater technological connectivity yet increasing isolation.

We are reminded of the prescient words of Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, in his 1967 book, *Where Do We Go From Here? Chaos or Community*, when he urged us to make a choice between chaos or community. At First Congregational Church we are clear that our choice must be community. That is our heritage and our calling.

Beyond Today: The First Congregational Church Endowment Campaign

As we deepen our commitment to community, reaching out beyond Sunday morning to meet the diverse needs we see around us, we know that a sustainable source of funding is foundational to our long-term vision. Building an endowment will provide a perpetual source of income to support the outreach mission of First Congregational Church.

How does an endowment work?

An endowment is a substantial cash reserve, built with donations over time and prudently invested so that it continues to grow. As the



endowment grows, it generates interest income which can be used to support programs. For example, an endowment of \$2,000,000, at a 5% annual spending rate, would generate \$100,000 of income each year. Because the principal is not being spent, only a portion of the investment income earned, the endowment generates income year after year after year.

As we celebrate the 150th anniversary of the founding of First Congregational Church – and the 40-year ministry of our senior pastor, Reverend Dr. Dwight Andrews – now is the perfect time to look ahead to the future and ensure that our good work beyond Sunday is sustainable beyond today.



How can you help?

Everyone can participate in our endowment campaign in some way...

Many people will want to participate by making meaningful contributions of cash, specifically designated for the endowment.

For some people, it may be possible and desirable to donate appreciated stock to the endowment (thereby avoiding any capital gains tax).

Others may want to make a planned gift to the First Church Endowment, perhaps naming First Congregational Church as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy, or as a named recipient in a will.
